¿What is an A-Level?

These are official British Sixth Form Curriculum examinations that students take during Year 12 and Year 13.

At the end of Year 12, students take the AS exams, and at the end of Year 13, the A2 exams. These exams are official and are issued and corrected by external examining boards, as a means to obtain the "Titulo de Bachiller". In total, each student takes an average of 4 subjects.

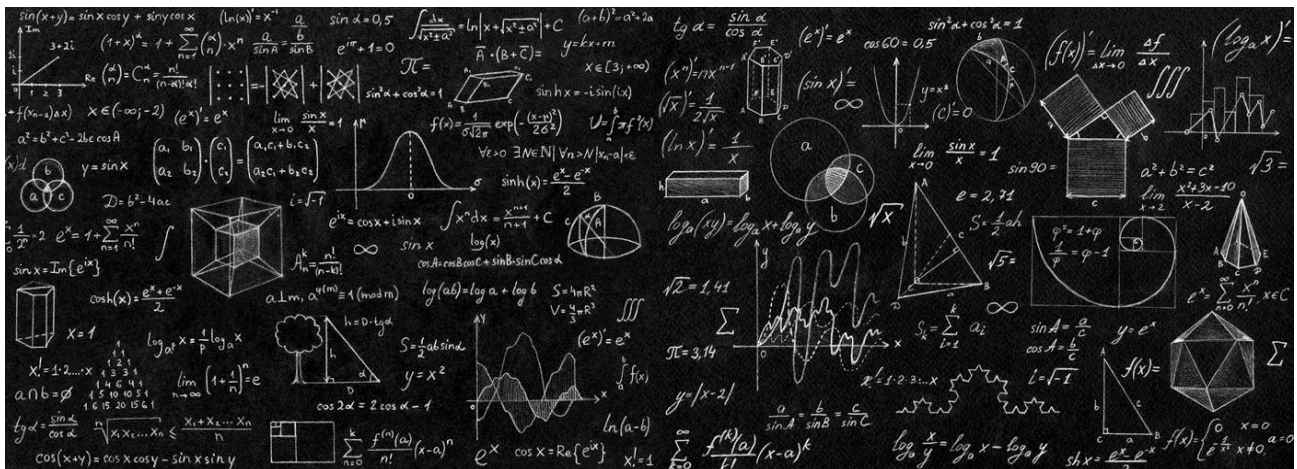

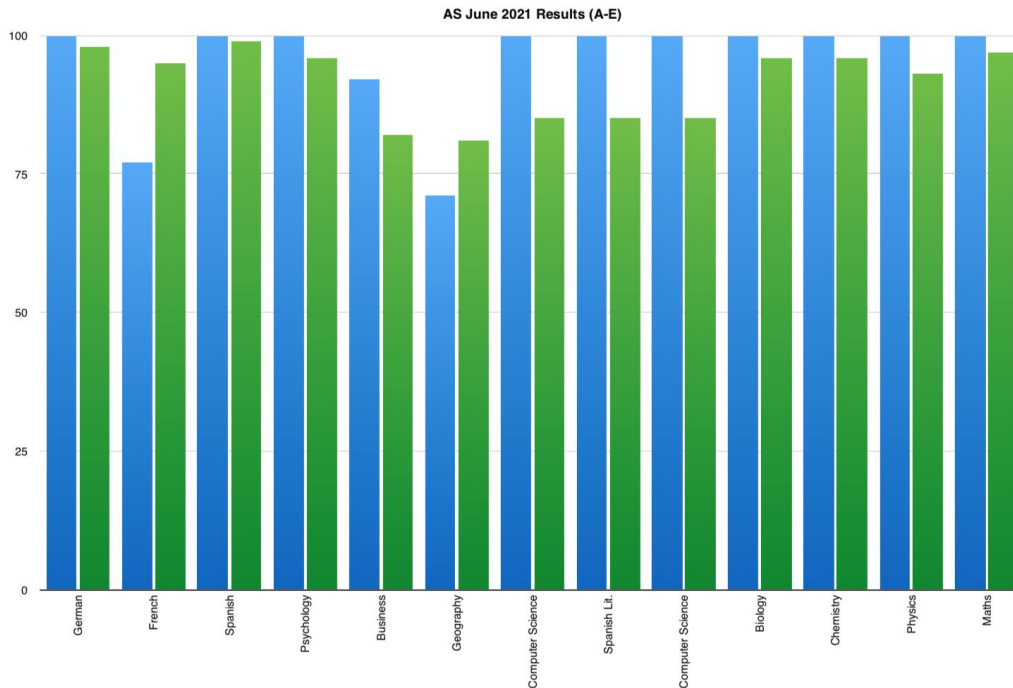
A* and A are the highest grades that can be obtained in A-levels.

The British System is very demanding when it comes to assessment, so obtaining these grades is unusual.

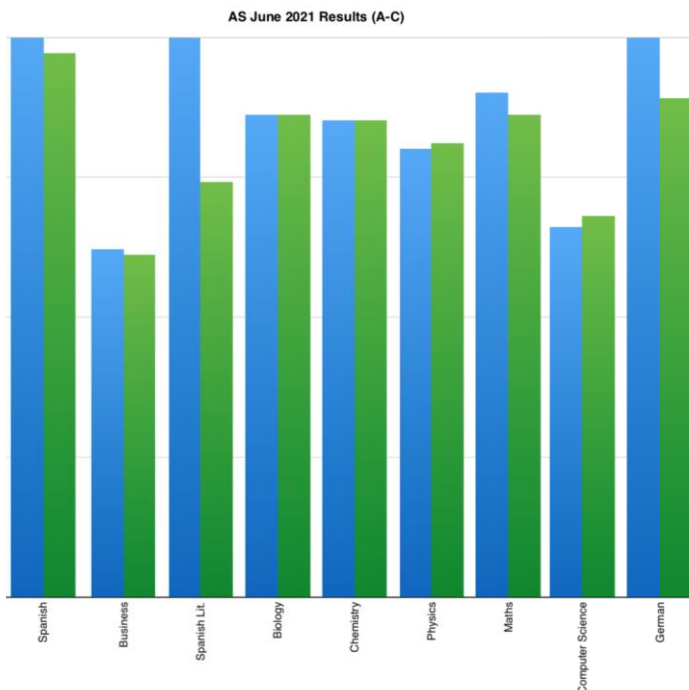


AS 2021 Official Exam Results (Year 12)

Virtually 100% of our students passed all AS exams (grades between A* and E) at the end of Year 12.



80% of our students obtained a grade between A* and C in their AS exams at the end of Year 12.



BSA and BSX students have obtained **excellent grades** in the AS (between A* and C) out achieving other students in subjects such as **Business, Maths, German, Spanish, Spanish and Spanish Literature.**

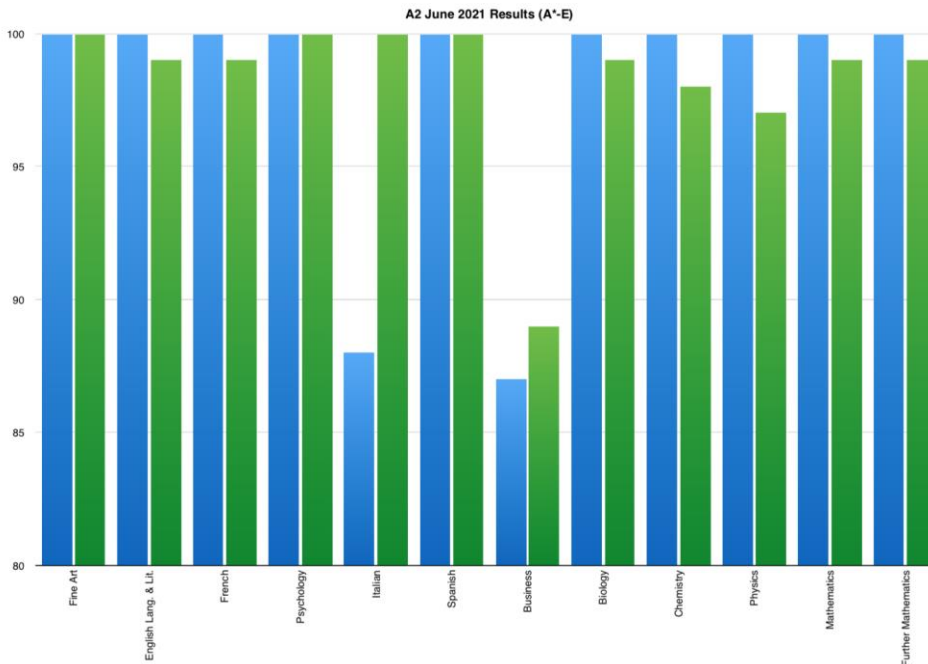
In subjects such as Computer Science, Physics, Chemistry, Biology our students have obtained excellent grades at the same level as the average of students globally.

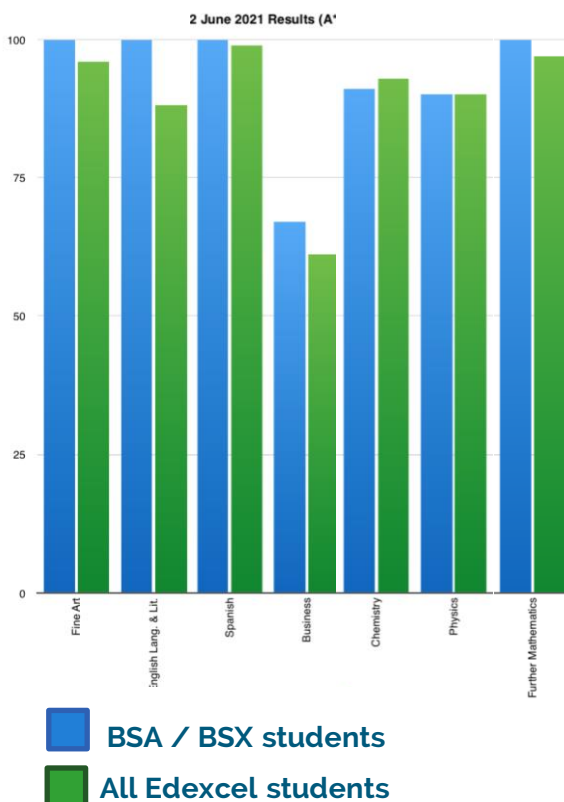

A2 2021 (Year 13) Official Examination Results

Practically 100% of our students passed all A2 exams (grades between A* and E) at the end of Year 13.



80% of our students obtained a grade between A* and C in their A2 exams at the end of Year 13.



BSA and BSX students have obtained **excellent grades** (between A* and C) in the A2s out achieving other students in subjects such as **Fine Art, English Language and Literature, Spanish, Business and Further Maths.**

In subjects such as Computer Science, Chemistry and Physics, our students have obtained excellent grades at the same level as the average of students globally.

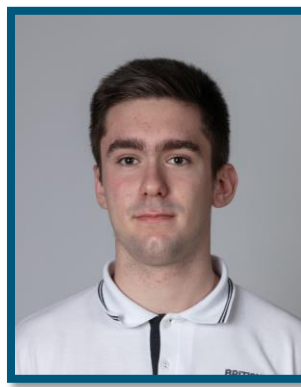

At the end of Year 11, students take the IGCSE, official exams issued and corrected by external examining boards, as a means to obtain the "Graduado en Educación Secundaria" (Secondary Education Graduate). In total, each student takes an average of 7 or 8 exams, including the 3 core subjects (Maths, English and Science). They must pass at least 5 subjects, 2 of which must be core subjects.

To pass, you must obtain at least a score of 4 points on the exam, and the maximum score is 9 points.

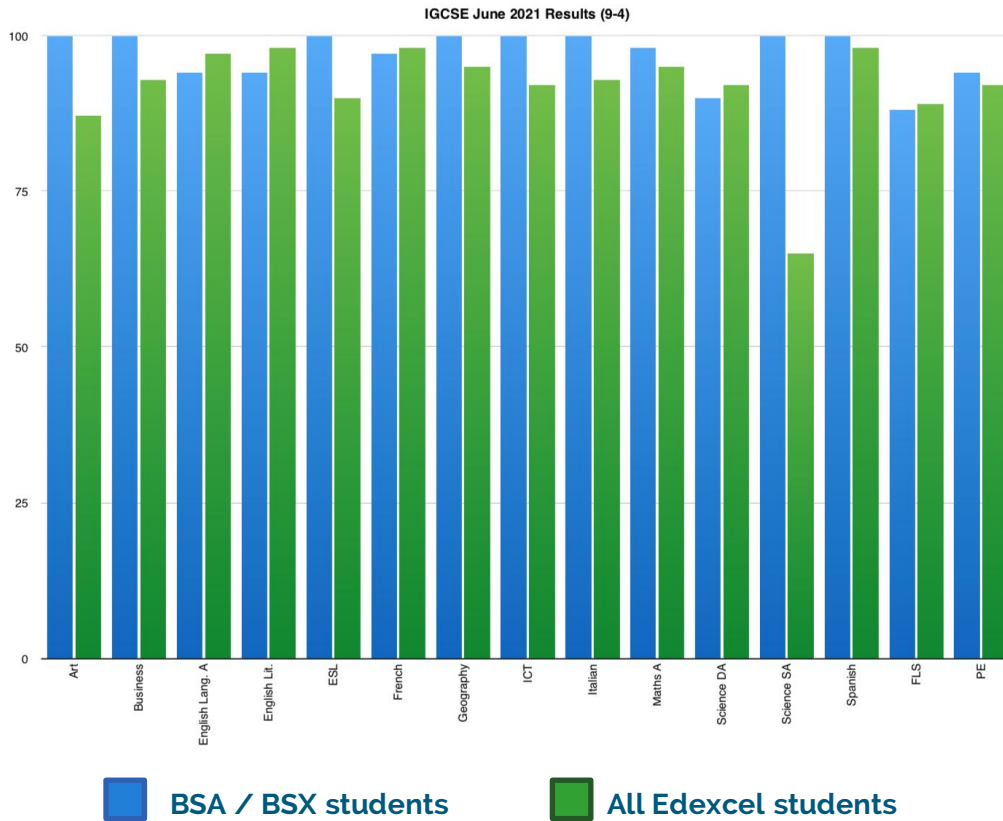

During the month of May, the final Key Stage 2 examinations (Year 6) in English Language, Mathematics and Science (GL Assessments) are carried out through an external assessment platform, which provides and guarantees a correct view of the student's performance, and allows us to offer valuable information to teachers so that they can optimize the support of students in their progress and learning in their Secondary stage.

GL Assessments have been used in the United Kingdom for many years and have a growing popularity in British schools in Spain. Across the UK and Internationally over 100,000 pupils sit these assessments each year.

The assessments are standardised against tens of thousands of pupils in the United Kingdom and Internationally.

This ensures their reliability as an indicator of pupil attainment.

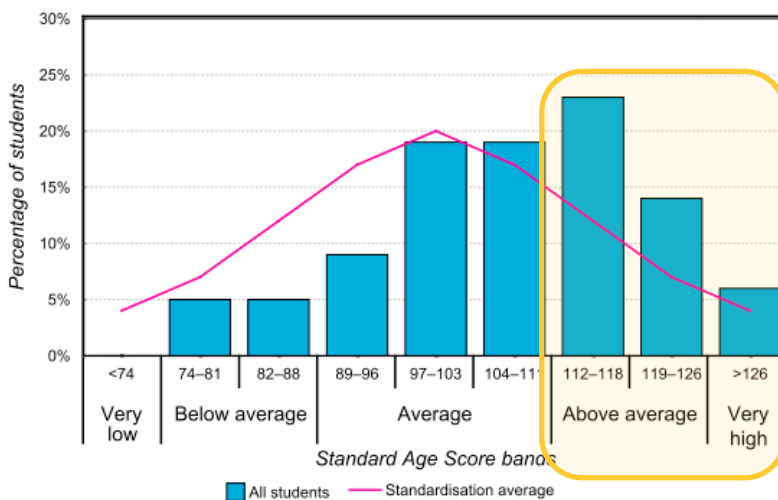

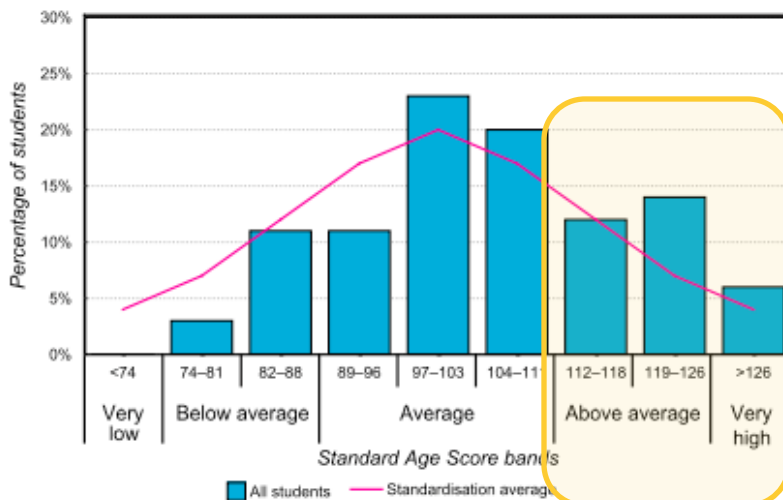

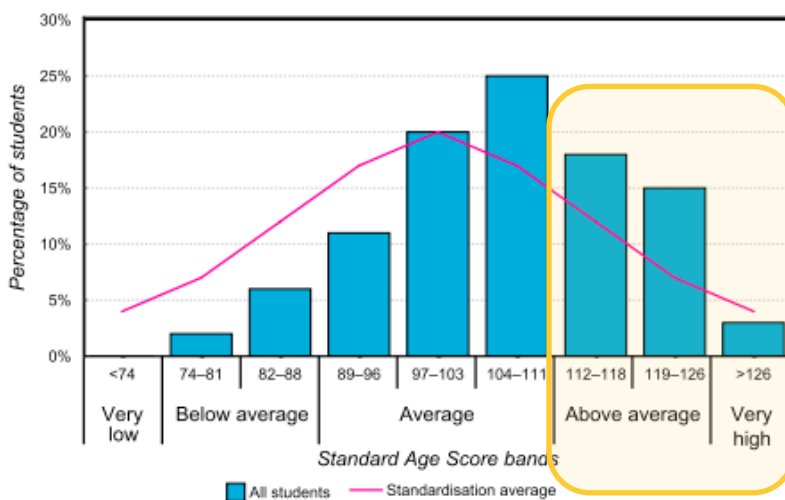
